Getting there:

Metro is an easy walk.

Parking: Unlimited underground pay parking at Columbia Plaza on Virginia Ave. (Approach from direction of Watergate Hotel)

There is limited underground parking at church (enter 24th Street; usually fills up by 7 pm).

For curbside parking, try Virginia Ave. east of 23rd; the earlier the better.
